



Echeveria is a genus of rosette-forming succulent plants with thick, fleshy leaves arranged in symmetri cal rosettes. They come in a variety of shapes, sizes, and colors, with some species producing offsets or "pups" around the base of the plant.

Echeverias are prized for their attractive foliage and ease of care, making them popular choices for container gardens, succulent arrangements, and rock gardens.
